All the finals games were completed over the Finals Weekend at Dorchester on $23^{rd}/24^{th}$ July at Dorchester with finalists qualified for Leamington. I believe it was a successful weekend with all trophies and gifts presented and photos taken by Janine. All trophies have been engraved and we are arranging for the trophies to be collected. The engraving has been done by Blandford Engraving at £5.50 per trophy - this is because we are regular customers – the current cost to new customers is between £7.50 - £10 per trophy.

Dorset Competitions
